- Beginning July 1, 2012, California State Law requires that all businesses that generate 4 or more yards of waste per week and apartments with 5 units or more must incorporate recycling as part of solid waste services.
- Recycling helps conserve resources and creates a healthier environment for our community and future generations.
- Providing recycling helps promote your business as environmentally friendly.


How to get started.

It's easy to recycle.

- Use the information on the inside of this brochure to learn what items are recyclable.
- To increase recycling efforts, make sure to separate your garbage from recyclable items.
- Place all garbage in a sealable trash bag. Place the sealed bag into the bin. The sealed bag will keep the recyclable materials cleaner.
- All recyclables are placed loosely into the bin.
- Once the bin is delivered to the Materials Recovery Facility, the bagged garbage is pulled out of the sorting line and sent to the landfill. The recyclable materials are sorted and separated and sent to processors for reuse.
